The Church of England Church of St. Mary the Virgin, Leake, is a mile to the north of Borrowby and Knayton on the east side of the A19. The Medieval Village of Leake has long gone, but the ancient church remains on the site where it was built in the 12th Century and has served the villages of Knayton and Borrowby for many centuries. It is now part of the "Hillside Parishes" of the Siltons, Cowesby, Kirby Knowle, Felixkirk and Boltby.
