The second payment of £1250.00 for precept 2004/5 received the committee agreed that 50% should be transferred to the deposit account.

Cheque number 000138 for £30.00 was issued to the village hall in February, 2003 and when compiling the annual accounts it was found that it had not been cleared by the bank. The village hall committee stated that they had no record of having received this cheque, on advice from the Council a further cheque was issued on the 16th June, 2004 number 000153.

Following receipt of a statement of account from the bank the original cheque number 000138 was cleared by TSB on the 17th June, 2004. The village hall committee have been made aware of this and the next invoice we receive from them for the hire of the hall will cover this additional payment.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

Following our letter to the Highways Agency regarding the condition of 'cats eyes' on the carriageway between Silton and Borrowby south bound they have instructed Autolink to look into this.

With regard to the road signs at Leake Church they consider that these signs are suitably positioned for the amount of traffic using this 'turn off'.

We are informed by North Yorkshire County Council that they are arranging for all verges in the village to be checked and re-seeded.

They are not responsible for the damaged notice board, it was agreed that this would be repaired locally.

'Ruts' along Main Street following recent storm water will receive attention.

The path from Knayton to Borrowby will receive attention when staff are available.

A works order has already been issued to repair the Iron Bridge and it will receive action as soon as possible.

The Parish Council have been notified of the following road closures:

- Northallerton to Knayton road between Carr Bridge and Park Lane Borrowby from 4th October 2004.
- Access road to north bound carriageway of A19 at Borrowby from 9th October 2004.

There was some concern at the re-siting of the mail box which was considered to be in the wrong place and an 'eye sore' it was questioned as to whether it would possible to reposition this.

The gravel which Yorkshire Water has available for Bob Lane has yet to be collected. The Chairman informed the meeting that Miss Mary Peckitt had agreed to make the necessary arrangement for delivery and laying.

The Chairman was asked to congratulate the grass cutting contractor on a job well done.

There was concern at the speed of vehicles crossing Crosby Bridge and 'give way' signs on both sides of the bridge were suggested. The clerk was requested to write to North Yorkshire County Council.
