

Minutes from the Borrowby Parish Council Meeting held on Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> April at 8.10 pm in Borrowby Village Hall

1. Apologies

Apologies were received from County Cllr G Dadd. Present: the Chairman (Cllr F Wachsberger), the Vice Chairman (Cllr D Craig), Cllr D Bell, Cllr E Town, Cllr J Dack, the Clerk, and six members of the public.

2. Minutes of Previous Meeting

The minutes from the meeting held on 17<sup>th</sup> March, which were previously circulated and read, were agreed and signed after correcting 9.2 about litter.

3. Matters Arising

3.1 Cllr Dack said that the damage to the grass outside Ashford Cottage has now been repaired.

3.2 Lambert Hospital – the Chairman said the public meeting had taken place and await the outcome.

3.3 Broken wooden slat on bench – Cllr Bell will get a spare piece of wood to fix this.

3.4 Some of the posts near the chestnut tree are in a poor condition and may need replacing.

3.5 Protection of corners of Green near Methodist chapel. Cllr Bell said small posts with white tape on were an option but the use of logs on the three corners, suggested by a resident, may be more in keeping with the surroundings.

3.6 Cllr Town said that she thought the kids club were having some celebrations to mark the Queen's birthday.

4. Update from County and District Councillors if present

5. Update from Borrowby Parish Councillors

Cllr Town reported that the gully near the pub had been marked for works. Cllr Bell said he had seen the gully clearer in the village the week before. Cllr Town said the gully was still overflowing so there is still a problem. Clerk to report again to Highways. A resident reported that a gully was blocked along Long Lane just outside St Helens.

The Chairman, Cllr Craig, Cllr Bell and Cllr Dack had nothing further to raise.

## 7. Planning Applications

7.1 Appeal Decision from the Planning Inspectorate for Riverside View, Woundales Lane, APP/G2713/C/15/3137463 regarding the fence. Site inspection, 7th March, decision date, 22<sup>ND</sup> March. The appeal decision is that the enforcement notice is upheld. The fence is to be removed within 3 months of the notice. The fence exceeds 1 metre and is adjacent to the Highway and clearly the fence is there as a boundary- the setting back by no more than a metre in parts from the nearest edge of the roadside verge is not sufficient to regards the fence as anything other than a roadside boundary. The low immature hedge in front of the fence is too insignificant to be seen as a property boundary. Where any part of the development exceeds permitted development limits, the whole development is unauthorised.

7.2 Planning application for alterations & extension to existing dwelling, installation of roof lights and a roof terrace at the first floor at the Chapel Field for Mr & Mrs Lowe (16/00517/FUL). Clerk to reply with no objections.

7.3 Planning Decision – Permission granted for 2 storey extension to rear, increase in roof height with a change of roof material to natural slate with dormer to rear elevation at Borrowby Hill (18/00324/FUL).
